To insert this music into your own worship aids, you can make TIFs or JPGs, etc., from the sheet music on each individual part. You can make those insertable pictures to include the title all the way down to the copyright line, or you can copy just the music section, then use the Text version for the correct title/composer/copyright in a more manipulatable format to fit your worship aid better.

*The last two pages of this PDF are a ready-to-print worship aid for your congregation. If you choose to print this up, be sure to print those last two pages **double-sided**, then **test one copy** to make sure the back page isn't upside-down. You may have to change your print settings to "flip on short side" or something similar. For a more permanent copy to re-use every year, we suggest printing on card stock. It helps to have an automated paper-folder (or some willing volunteers) to fold them in half.*

Card-stock versions of this fit easily into the plastic slips in the backs of some hardbound hymnals, but keep in mind the Amen and Lamb of God will be hidden unless it's removed by the congregant every time. For this reason, it's best to just keep them loose in the pew racks, especially since it's only for 4 weeks of the year.



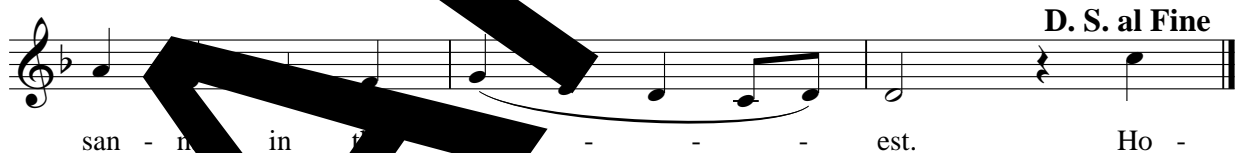
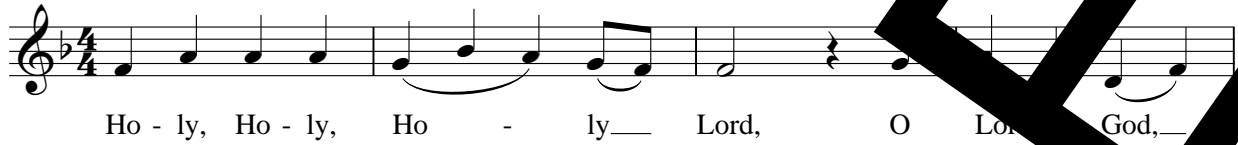
