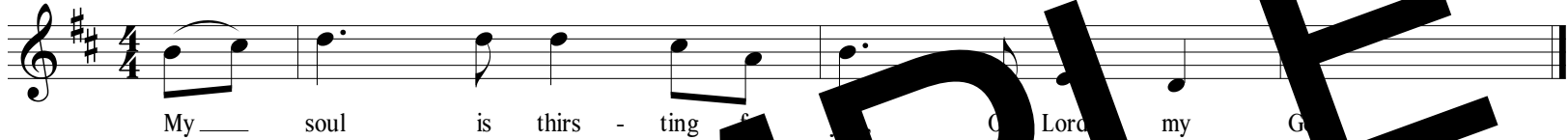


# My Soul Is Thirsting for You
