

Against conven I have icaly as it would be sung in its original guttural Hebrew rather than our Anglicize ess on *la* ect the vowels to the 'l' consonants and sing it as lel. Since Hebrew has no vow only sonants followed by diacretical marks, I have player intentionally on the ice. As a word, Alleluia has much more meaning than the sounds of its 'ls', to turn the word' construction; writing is y a developed way of expressing concepts, and in more ancient languages rew, there are er words to communiate an entire spectrum of meaning. We regard words expressing concepts, Hel is expressive of reality itself. Psalm 150, the final psalm of the fives ooks of the Psal e dramatic phrase, Let every breath in my body be a song of praise, "Halleluya! nsfered this commitment into my added doxology, as befits any Sunday in Eastertide


