come to us and restore us.


At daybreak, show us your kindness,





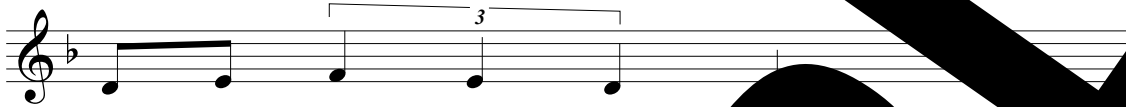
