Yes! The oppressed find God's saving hand.

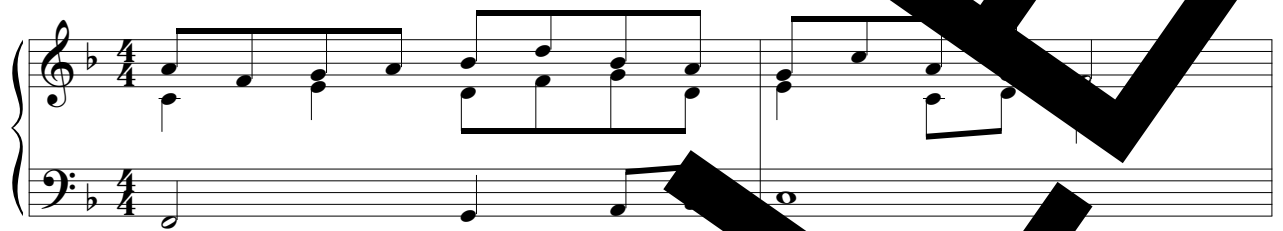

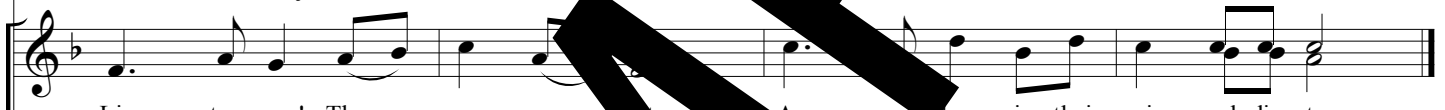

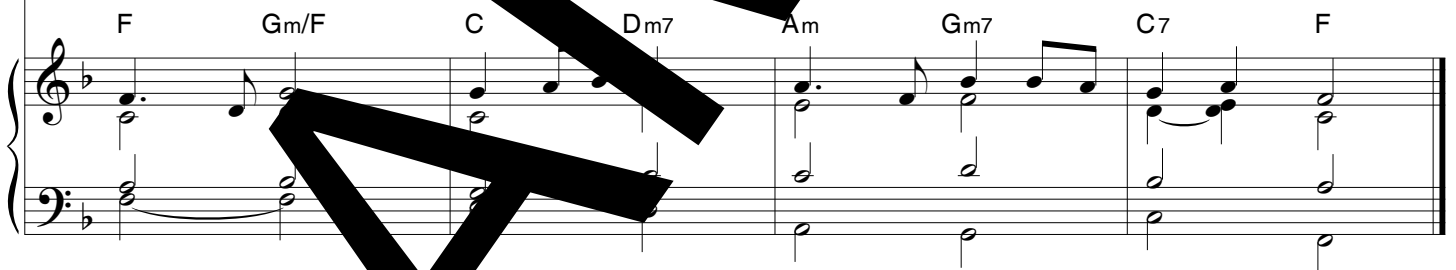
