A note from the preface of the 2010, the English translation of the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed that Jesus was "born of the Virgin Mary" in the current English translation of the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed. "Incarnate of the Father before all ages" "incarnate of the Virgin Mary." The use of the word "incarnate" in the English translation of the Nicene Creed is to express the divine nature of Jesus and a beautiful expression of the human nature of Jesus—especially when contrasted with "born of the Father before all ages" which expresses the divine nature of Jesus. The use of the word "incarnate" on these phrases has been a source of inspiration for many composers. The quotes on the front cover are:
