Pentecost Vigil 3, *alternate response* • 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time, *alternate response*

### Notes:

The Lectionary Response for this psalm uses a comma instead of a semicolon after "Lord."

The Alleluia alternate response for 12 O.T. was added in the 1981 edition of the Lectionary, bringing it into line with the Pentecost Vigil alternate response.

*Psalm 107:10-13, 14-15, 16-17, 18-19, 20-21, 22-23, 24-25, 26-27, 28-29, 30-31. R/ v. 1b*

1. Let the redeemed of the LORD say,  
those whom he has redeemed from the hand of distress,  
And gathered from the lands,  
from the east and the west, from the north  
and the south. *R/*
2. They went astray in the desert wilderness;  
the way to an inhabited city they did not know.  
Hungry and thirsty,  
their life was wasting away within them. *R/*
3. They cried to the LORD in their distress;  
from their straits he rescued them.  
And he led them by a direct path  
to reach an inhabited city. *R/*
4. Let them give thanks to the LORD for his kindness,  
and his wondrous deeds to the children of men.  
Because he satisfied the hungry soul  
and filled the empty belly with bread. *R/*

1. They voyaged on the sea in ships,  
trading in the deep waters,  
they saw the works of the LORD  
and his wonders in the abyss. *R/*
2. They demanded and raised up a storm wind  
which raised its waves on high.  
They mounted up to heaven; they sank  
to the depths; their hearts melted away in their plight. *R/*
3. They cried to the LORD in their distress;  
from their straits he rescued them,  
he hushed the storm to a gentle breeze,  
and the billows of the sea were stilled. *R/*
4. They rejoiced that they were calmed,  
and he brought them to their desired haven.  
Let them give thanks to the LORD for his kindness  
and his wondrous deeds to the children of men. *R/*
