 [omit C]  
 among all peoples, his wondrous deeds. R/

**29 OT C only**

2a. For great is the LORD and highly to be praised;  
 awesome is, beyond all gods.  
 For all the gods of the nations are things of nought,  
 but the LORD made the heavens. R/

**Christmas Midnight only**

3. Let the heavens be glad and rejoice;  
 let the sea and what fills it rejoice;  
 let the plains be joyful and rejoice in them.  
 Then shall all the trees of the forest rejoice. R/

**29 OT A and 2 OT C only**

3a. Give to the LORD, you families of nations,  
 give to the LORD glory and praise;  
 [omit C]  
 give to the LORD the glory due his name! [R/]

**Christmas Midnight only**

4. They shall praise the LORD, for he conquered  
 for he conquered to rule the earth.  
 He shall rule the world with equity  
 and the people with his compassion. R/

**29 OT A only**

[\*] Bring gifts and enter his courts. R/

\* For 29 OT A, treat v. 3a as a four-measure verse.

**29 OT A and 2 OT C only**

4a. Worship the LORD in holy attire.  
 Tremble before him, all the earth;  
 say among the nations: The LORD is king.  
 He governs the peoples with equity. R/
