Thank you for choosing **Cher & Gene Klosner's psalm series!**

All of our psalms are written in comfortable "congregational keys," and presented in SATB(+), but have been written so that all music ministry groups can use them, from soloist to duo, to contemporary praise teams (SAT), to full choirs. Also available in Soloist/Small Group format.

This PDF contains the following versions:

- Refrain Full Score + Verse chords (for director, piano accompanist)
- Refrain P/G/V + Verse chords (for piano accompanist)
- Refrain Lead Sheet + Verse chords (for cantor, guitar accompanist, piano "chorders" - similar to guitar books)
- Refrain SSATB (for choir members)
- Verse P/G/V (for cantor, accompanist) - covers all uses of this refrain (choice of psalm tone 5, 6, or 7)
- Refrain Assembly (for director, worship aid makers)

Format:

- Solo cantor refrain melody*
- Choir and congregation respond in **unison** (melody) refrain
- Solo cantor verse
- Choir and congregation refrain with harmonies
- [Continue thru multiple verses and harmonized refrains]
- End with repeat of harmonized refrain (optional)

*The melody line is the soprano part (male or female singer sings an octave below), unless otherwise indicated.

Verses are by **ONE cantor**, chant-style (non-metered, free rhythm) using any one of the choice of melodies, depending on their vocal range. Verses are not designed for multiple singers with harmonies.

For the **accompanist**, the rhythm resumes (a tempo) on the last word of each verse to bring choir and congregation in for the refrain, which then has **choir** harmonies from there on out.

We like to do a double refrain after the last verse to "close out" the psalm, so we use the turnaround accompaniment for repeating the refrain, then the Final ending at the very end.

Psalm Tones:

Overall, we have 16 different melodies for psalm tones, but the verses that get "mixed and matched" with all the hundreds of different psalm refrains throughout the 3-year cycle. One per psalm tone, anyway, a cantor doesn't have to learn hundreds of different verse melodies over the three-year cycle. We normally give two options from which the cantor can choose, depending on the cantor's vocal range; for this psalm, we actually give two sets of options, since we would just as easily use 5 or 6 as we would 7 (which has some optional lower notes). Choose the smaller number for the lower melody.

The particular psalm tones that lead to this refrain are Psalm Tone 6 in D, which starts up a fifth from the end of the refrain (Sol in solfege), and Psalm Tone 7 in D, which starts up a third from the end of the refrain (Mi in solfege).

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Other tips: Will Draw Water

Solo Cantor: Use with Psalm Tone 5, 6, or 7 (in D).

The Lead Sheet/PGV refrain is presented in treble clef for simplicity.

All singers: For the syllable "n" in "salvation," emphasize the "n" more than the vowel, so it feels like "shunnn."

All parts are in unison octaves on the "springs of sal-" in m. 6.

We strongly recommend listening to the recordings of this psalm.




